

CORPORATION OF THE COUNTY OF PERTH

BY-LAW NUMBER 2997

A By-Law to continue with the One-Third Tax-Free Allowance for County Council Remuneration

WHEREAS Section 283(4) of The Municipal Act, 2001 states that no part of the remuneration of a member of a council or local board paid under this section is deemed to be for expenses incidental to his or her duties as a member and a municipality or local board shall not provide that any part of the remuneration is for such deemed expenses; and

WHEREAS Section 283(5) of The Municipal Act, 2001 states that despite Subsection 4, if a resolution of a municipality under subsection 255(2) of the old Act is not revoked before January 1, 2003, the resolution shall be deemed to be a by-law of the municipality and one-third of the remuneration paid to the elected members of the council and its local boards is deemed as expenses incidental to the discharge of their duties as members of the council or local board; and

WHEREAS it is the intention of Perth County Council pursuant to Section 478(10) of the Municipal Act, 2001, that one-third of the remuneration paid to the elected members of Perth County Council shall continue as expenses incidental to the discharge of their duties as members of County Council.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the County of Perth enacts as follows:

1. That for the balance of the term of office for Perth County Council that one-third of the remuneration paid to the elected members of Perth County Council shall continue as expenses incidental to the discharge of their duties as members of Perth County Council.

Read a first and second time this 21st day of December 2006.

Read a third time and finally passed this 21st day of December 2006.
