

THE CORPORATION OF THE COUNTY OF PERTH

BY-LAW NO. 3001

BEING a BY-LAW for the APPOINTMENT of AUDITORS

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, 2001, c. 25, s. 296 (1) provides that the Council of a municipality shall appoint an auditor licensed under the *Public Accounting Act, 2004* who is responsible for annually auditing the accounts and transactions of the municipality and its local boards and expressing an opinion on the financial statements of these bodies based on the audit; and

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, 2001, c. 25, s. 296 (3) states that an auditor of a municipality shall not be appointed for a term exceeding five years; and

WHEREAS Council deems it expedient to appoint auditors for a one-year term for the period January 1, 2007 to December 31, 2007;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE COUNTY OF PERTH
HEREBY APPOINTS:

The firm of BDO Dunwoody LLP as auditors for the Corporation of the County of Perth for the period January 1, 2007 to December 31, 2007.

This by-law comes into force upon the final passing thereof.
