

THE CORPORATION OF THE COUNTY OF PERTH

BY-LAW NO. 3010

BEING a By-law to approve the acquiring of certain lands for road widening purposes in the County of Perth to be used as public highways.

WHEREAS Section 31(1) of The Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, Chapter 24 states that a municipality may by by-law establish a highway; and

WHEREAS Section 31(2) of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, Chapter 24 states that after January 1, 2003, land may only become a highway by virtue of a by-law passed under subsection (1) and not by the activities of the municipality or any other person in relation to the land, including the spending of public money; and

WHEREAS the Corporation of the County of Perth is desirous of acquiring land for road widening purposes.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the County of Perth enacts as follows:

1. The lands hereinafter described are and the same are hereby declared to be a public highway:

Perth Road 121

South of Perth Line 72 being Part Lot 15, Concession 6, Township of Perth East, Mornington Ward, designated as PART 1 on Reference Plan 44R4325 deposited in the Registry Office for the Registry Division of the County of Perth on June 30, 2005 and said Transfer registered as Instrument No PC27538.

Perth Line 20

West of Line 122 being Part Lot 1, Registrar's Compiled Plan 453, Township of Perth South, Downie Ward, designated as PART 4 on Reference Plan 44R4331 deposited in the Registry Office for the Registry Division of the County of Perth on July 28, 2005 and said Transfer registered as Instrument No. PC32852.

Perth Line 37

West of Road 109 being Part Lot 32, Concession 2, Township of Perth East, North Easthope Ward, designated as PART 1 on Reference Plan 44R4404 deposited in the Registry Office for the Registry Division of the County of Perth on May 12, 2006 and said Transfer registered as Instrument No. PC37636.

2. This By-Law shall take effect and come into force upon the final passing thereof.

Read a first and second time this 1st day of March 2007.

Read a third time and finally passed this 1st day of March 2007.
