

BY-LAW NUMBER 3027, A.D. 2007

THE CORPORATION OF THE COUNTY OF PERTH

TO REPEAL THE CORPORATION OF THE COUNT OF PERTH BY-LAW NUMBER 2361 FOR LICENSING, REGULATING AND GOVERNING AUCTIONEERS AND OTHER PERSONS SELLING OR PUTTING UP FOR SALE GOODS, WARES, MERCHANDISE OR EFFECTS BY PUBLIC AUCTION

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the County of Perth passed By-law No. 2361 on the 12th day of February, 1987 for the purpose of licensing, regulating and governing auctioneers and other persons selling or putting up for sale goods, wares, merchandise or effects by public auction.

AND WHEREAS Perth County Council on June 7, 2007, by motion of Council expressed their desire to discontinue the issuing of Auctioneer's Licenses in the County of Perth.

NOW THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE COUNTY OF PERTH ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That By-law No. 2361 of the Corporation of the County of Perth is hereby repealed.
2. This By-law shall come into force and take effect on the 1st day of January 2008.

Read a third time and finally passed this 21st day of June, 2007.
