

CORPORATION OF THE COUNTY OF PERTH

BY-LAW NUMBER 3077

By-Law to Allow for One-Third of Council Remuneration as Expenses Incident to the Discharge of Council Member Duties

WHEREAS Section 283(4) of the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, c.25 (the Act) states that no part of the remuneration of a member of a council or local board paid under this section is deemed to be for expenses incidental to his or her duties as a member and a municipality or local board shall not provide that any part of the remuneration is for such deemed expenses; and

WHEREAS Section 283(5) of the Act states that despite Subsection 4, if a resolution of a municipality under subsection 255(2) of the old Act is not revoked before January 1, 2003, the resolution shall be deemed to be a by-law of the municipality and one-third of the remuneration paid to the elected members of the council and its local boards is deemed as expenses incident to the discharge of their duties as members of the council or local board; and

WHEREAS in accordance with Section 283(5) of the Act, the County of Perth passed by-law #2816 on the 19th day of February 2004, thereby deeming that one-third of the remuneration paid to the elected members of the council and its local boards is deemed as expenses incident to the discharge of their duties as members of the council or local board; and

WHEREAS Section 285(7) of the Act states that on or after December 1, 2003 a council shall review a by-law under subsection (5) at a public meeting at least once during the four-year period corresponding to the term of the office of its members after a regular election; and

WHEREAS it is the intention of the County of Perth that one-third of the remuneration paid to the elected members of Perth County Council shall continue as expenses incident to the discharge of their duties as members of County Council.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the County of Perth enacts as follows:

That by-law number 2816 be hereby repealed; and

That for the balance of the 2007 to 2010 term of office for Perth County Council, that one-third of the remuneration paid to the elected members of Perth County Council shall continue as expenses incident to the discharge of their duties as members of Perth County Council.
