

THE CORPORATION OF THE COUNTY OF PERTH

BY-LAW NUMBER 3110

**Being a By-Law to designate the St Marys Emergency Medical Services Base
as a Municipal Capital Facility**

WHEREAS the County of Perth entered into a 20-year Lease-to-Own Agreement dated December 6, 2007 under Section 8 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, with the St Marys Memorial Hospital for the purpose of constructing an ambulance base on Part of Lots 1, 2, 3 and 4, Block E, Plan 216, Town of St. Marys; and

WHEREAS the County of Perth provides emergency medical services to the County of Perth, City of Stratford and Town of St. Marys; and

WHEREAS the County of Perth constructed a building on the property for the entire occupancy and use as a land ambulance base and is owner/tenant of same; and

WHEREAS Section 110(1) of the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, c25 provides that a municipality may enter into agreements for the provision of municipal capital facilities by any person, including another municipality; and

WHEREAS Section 110(6) of the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, c25 provides that the council of a municipality may exempt from all or part of the taxes levied for municipal and school purposes land or a portion of it on which municipal capital facilities are or will be located; and


WHEREAS 'provision of social and health services' is one of the municipal capital facility classes stated in Section 2(1) of O. Reg. 603/96; and

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the County of Perth enacts as follows:

1. That the St. Marys Emergency Medical Services ambulance base located on Part of Lots 1,2, 3 and 4, Block E, Plan 216, Town of St. Marys, and municipally known as 241 Queen St., be hereby designated as a municipal capital facility.
