It is necessary to complete and submit this form with an application for Consent to Sever, where the proposal involves the severance of a dwelling that is surplus to farm needs.

Provincial policies discourage residential lot creation in prime agricultural areas, and only allow such severances to be considered for dwellings made surplus to a farming operation as a result of farm consolidation (i.e. farm expansion). By filling out this form, the farm owner is providing information needed to determine if a proposed severance is consistent with these policies.
